

## Internship offer: Communication and Outreach Support

### Sector:

Ocean and Climate, environment

### Description:

The [Ocean and Climate Platform](#) is an international multi-stakeholder network that brings together 97 members: NGOs, foundations, research centres, universities, public institutions, and associations of private firms all working together to raise awareness on the inter-linkages between ocean, climate and biodiversity.

The communication intern will work in collaboration with the science and advocacy teams to support the dissemination of the various projects.

### The Intern's responsibilities will include:

- **Communication support:**
  - Draft a wide range of communication materials including meeting reports, conference documents, newsletters, blog articles, press releases and policy briefs
  - Draft communication strategies for the World Ocean Day 2022, the 2<sup>nd</sup> UN Ocean Conference and the 6th IPCC report
  - Creation of content around the ocean-climate-biodiversity solutions provided by the members of the OCP network
  - Regularly update the Platform's social media accounts (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn) and the website with previously produced digital content
- **Outreach support:**
  - Follow-up on key international processes, such as the UNFCCC, CBD, BBNJ, IPCC, UN Decade of Ocean Science
  - Follow-up of scientific production with a focus on the ocean-climate-biodiversity nexus
  - Assist with the organization of national and international conferences, meetings and webinars.
  - Assist with the organization of regular meetings with network members

### Skills and qualifications:

- Excellent command of **English** and **French** (oral and written)
- Excellent writing skills and attention to detail
- Strong organizational skills and ability to **work with minimum supervision**
- Strong knowledge of international environmental affairs and governance (Scientific knowledge allowing a good understanding of the relationship between ocean, climate and biodiversity)
- Good skills in social media management
- Good knowledge of Wordpress would be an asset

**Academic background:** Be enrolled in a masters' degree or in third year of bachelor in environmental science, communication, or in political science. Background in oceanography or in scientific mediation would be an asset.
