



Internship offer: Communication and mobilisation

About the Ocean & Climate Platform (OCP):

The OCP is an multi-stakeholder NGO gathering more than 110 members. OCP's objective is to raise awareness among political decision-makers and general public of the importance of the interlinkages between ocean, climate and biodiversity, and to advocate for "a healthy ocean and a protected climate".

Main Responsibilities:

- Support the **mobilisation of civil society in the context of the 3rd United Nations Ocean Conference** (Nice, June 2025) and the "Year of the Sea": organising events, coordinating joint statements (e.g., op-eds), developing partnerships, etc.
- **Writing a wide range of communication content** (both internal and external) related to international policy issues (e.g., thematic articles, visuals, event programs, newsletters, etc.)
- Managing **social media accounts** (Twitter/X, LinkedIn, Instagram).
- Assisting in the **organisation of events and meetings with the OCP network**, including the annual members' seminar
- Strategic monitoring of **political and scientific news** on the ocean-climate-biodiversity nexus

Required Skills:

- Excellent command of both English and French (oral and written)
- Excellent writing skills and attention to detail
- Strong organisational skills and ability to work with minimum supervision
- Knowledge of international climate and environmental governance.
- Proficiency in social media management and communication tools (e.g., Canva, Mailchimp)

Academic background: Master's degree in communication, journalism, political science, international relations, or a related field.
