

## Internship offer: International Policy Assistant

## About the Ocean & Climate Platform (OCP):

The Ocean & Climate Platform (OCP) is an international network of more than 115 organisations from civil society (NGOs, scientific institutes, universities, foundations, public institutions, business associations and local authorities) working at the science-policy interface to promote scientific expertise on the major role played by the ocean in the global climate system, and to advocate for better consideration of these interactions by decision-makers.

## The intern's responsibilities will include:

- Assist with policy activities on the ocean-climate-biodiversity nexus (e.g., development of
  policy briefs and position papers), and follow-up of international processes (e.g., UNFCCC,
  CBD, BBNJ Agreement).
- Assist with the coordination of mobilisation activities, including as part of the Ocean Breakthroughs campaign.
- Assist with the organisation of international meetings, events and workshops.
- Conduct independent research on ocean-climate-biodiversity related topics and draft a
  wide range of information materials (e.g., meeting minutes, factsheets, and blog articles)
  and other support documents (e.g., visuals, PowerPoint).

- Strong ability to work with little supervision

- · Strong research and analysis skills
- · Knowledge of international environmental affairs and governance
